BILL OF RIGHTS

As a volunteer Firefighter and or EMT,

you have the right to:

- An environment in which the volunteer is treated as a professional and as a valued asset – not just free labor
- Receive respect, recognition and reward for attitude and performance
- Know as much as possible about the organization, policies, people and programs
- Sound guidance, supervision and direction with a job description clearly defined
- Suitable assignments according to your abilities, knowledge, location, experience and desires
- Quality training commensurate with agency, local, county, state and national standards and appropriate to your assignment
- Be heard and participate in planning
- Receive periodic evaluations and feedback
- Frequent expressions of appreciation from other volunteers and the community
